

Your Access To Affordable Medication Is About To Change



The United States government is trying to limit the access of its residents to safe and affordable medications from outside the US. On October 22, 2026 the **US Customs and Border Patrol (CBP)** together with the **Food and Drug Administration (FDA)** will be implementing changes that will prohibit any medication from entering the country via the postal service (USPS). This change is **global in scope** meaning it applies to packages sent to the US from anywhere in the world, not just those mailed from Canada. This issue is separate from any tariff-related matters, and this is not related to the current Canada-US trade negotiations.

The implications are clear:

This will force you to pay more for the same brand name medication that is available for less money in other countries,

This will force you to pay for more expensive brand name medications if there are no generic versions approved in the US, even if more affordable generic versions are available in other countries.
